Please make sure to bring:

1. Sketchbook (any regular unlined sketch paper book will work well, preferably 9x12" in size). A partially used sketchbook will work as long as most of the pages are available, and sketchbooks smaller or larger than 9x12" are fine as well. If you've ever wanted to recreate one of your sketched images into a watercolor painting, feel free to bring your past ideas and creativity into this course. Bring a pencil to use for your sketchbook drawings.
2. Watercolor sketchpad and/or mixed media sketchpad (rated for watercolors). 9x12" or larger, clean and unused.
3. Watercolor pencils (at least a 12-pack recommended).
4. Paint brushes (3 round brushes sizes 2-8 to get a good variety) and 2 flat brushes (sizes 1" & 1/2") plus any other brush you'd like to bring, empty cup to hold water for watercolors, watercolor paint palette (most kits include the palette) and last but not least:
5. Watercolor paint set

Winsor & Newton or Reeves are great brands when looking in craft stores for watercolor paints and for the most part it is true that you get what you pay for when you are looking at which brand of paint brushes and watercolor paint to choose. Better quality materials will allow you to create stronger pieces of art with ease, and Crafts stores, Art supply stores, Amazon, and Target offer a good selection of these materials depending on where you shop for supplies.
