SUPPLY LIST

Please ensure you have the following supplies ready for the workshop:

Paper:

- 20 sheets of cheap paper or the back side of failed drawings for quick warm-up poses.
- Canson Mi-Teintes (70 x 50 cm), any light color. Bring 3 or 4 sheets of white, cut in half.
- 1 sheet Rives BFK white paper (22 x 30 cm), cut or torn into halves or quarters, or other high-quality watercolor paper (e.g., Arches).
- Arches cold press or hot press white paper, a block is fine, in a size you are comfortable with (smaller sizes fine).

Brushes:

- One wide flat brush (1")
- One round, medium brush (size 8-10). If you have a floppy squirrel brush in size 10, bring it! Also one firmer sable or imitation sable in this size.
- One round, smaller firm (sable or imitation sable) brush (size 4-6)
- Any additional brushes you might find useful.

Watercolors:

- Cadmium Yellow Light
- Yellow Ochre
- Cadmium Red
- Alizarin Crimson
- Indigo
- Cobalt Blue
- Ultramarine Blue
- Winsor Blue Green Shade
- Ivory Black
- Burnt Sienna
- Permanent Sap Green
- Plus any additional colors you love, such as Violet, Pink, Sepia, etc.
